Student-Actor Commitment Contract

Participation in the Tri-School Productions theatre program is completely voluntary. However, it requires a commitment from the student with respect to academic standing, citizenship, cast and crew mates and the three schools. Student-Actors are expected to be role models of their school’s mission. The following policies have been established for all student-actors:

You are a Student first

As a Student-Actor I agree to:

1. Maintain all academic requirements set by my school.
2. Demonstrate an appropriate online presence. Personal websites, blogs and social media are considered an extension of how a student represents themselves and the schools. Pictures and/or information included on such sites will be considered the truth. Any student who has this information or acts/speaks in a derogatory way on personal websites, blogs or social media will be held to the same standards as if acting in person, even if done with privacy settings activated.
3. Abide by all rules established by Tri-School Productions and the student-parent handbook of my school and cooperate with castmates, directors, staff and parent volunteers at all times.
4. Attend all rehearsals, performances and meetings - on time. Any absence must be provided to your director/stage manager prior to the absence. Rehearsals will range from to 10-15 hours a week. TECH Day (the Saturday prior to opening night) will run for 12 hours. During the week prior to opening night, rehearsal and performance times will be 5 hours each night.
5. Have all known conflicts approved by the production manager and director by the deadline (see production calendar for exact deadline). You may not be absent, without approval, except for illness/family emergency. Conflicts having to do with school clubs, student government activities and extracurriculars are subject to advance approval.

**An excess of unapproved conflicts may result in removal from the production.*

I, as a parent or guardian, allow my student to be photographed and/ or videotaped for the purposes of marketing, yearbook, school clubs and other organizations for all three participating schools.

By signing below, I agree to all guidelines and rules stated above. Failure to comply with any established rule, or the guidelines stated above, will be grounds for immediate suspension or dismissal from the production by your Director, Production Manager, Artistic Director or Assistant Principal.
